


Bill Kraft - 1935

Bill Kraft was an important "founding father" of the St. Mary's athletic tradition. During the 1930s, St. Mary had its earliest notable athletic successes in basketball. As a tall, strong, agile forward, our inductee was a key performer on the St. Mary hardcourt squad which won the Catholic State Championship in 1935. In recognition of his talent and productivity, Bill was awarded a spot on the All State Catholic 2nd team in 1935.

Our inductee was also a vital "skill" player on the 1934 St. Mary football squad, which was our school's best team of the 1930s. From his tailback position, Bill was an elusive runner, an accurate passer and the team's punter. During the 1934 season, Bill's gridiron team secured important victories over Paterson Central and Lincoln High School of Jersey City, and also tied undefeated St. Peter's Prep of Jersey City. Each spring, our inductee also performed as an outstanding pitcher on the Gaels' baseball team.

After graduation from St. Mary's, Bill Kraft moved on to higher education at Drake Business School and Fairleigh Dickinson University. He enjoyed a successful, lifelong career as an accountant and was a leader in civic and church affairs in his hometowns. Bill and his wife, Mary, lived in Ringwood for over 50 years, and have five children, seven grandchildren and three great grandchildren.



Marty McGonigle - 1959 - Contributor

Since its inception, the St. Mary Athletic Hall of Fame has inducted special individuals who, by their tireless and selfless work and devotion to St. Mary's, richly deserve recognition as Contributors. This year, another worthy Contributor, Marty McGonigle, is recognized for his years of service and devotion to St. Mary's.

Marty McGonigle was a founding member of the Thomas Holden Memorial Foundation. The works of the foundation include the Thomas Holden MVP Golf Classic, an annual NY Giants Season Ticket raffle and the overseeing of the Thomas Holden Memorial MVP Award, presented to the St. Mary MVP of each St. Mary Homecoming Football Game. The Thomas Holden Memorial Foundation has awarded over \$150,000 in financial assistance to St. Mary students seeking a Catholic education since its inception in 1998.

Thomas Holden, a graduate of St. Mary's class of 1959, was Marty's dear friend and classmate who died serving his country in the Vietnam War. It is through Marty and the Thomas Holden Foundation that the memory of this beloved recipient of two Silver Stars still remains fresh in our minds today. His unselfishness and commitment to his friends and others, much like Marty's, continues to be a strong thread woven through generations of St. Mary's athletics.

Marty is a charter and current member of the St. Mary High School Alumni Board of Directors where his expertise in sales and marketing has assisted the Merit Scholarship program, which attracts the best and brightest students to St. Mary's.

He was also instrumental in the promotion of the successful "Recapture the Dream" campaign which has led to many long overdue improvements to the school facility, most notably the rebuilding of the school gymnasium lobby. The new lobby named after 1959 graduate, Jack Sloan, will be the future home of the St. Mary Athletic Hall of Fame and include a second story that will house athletic and alumni offices. The new lobby addition and the George Vuyosevich Memorial Gymnasium together will comprise St. Mary's "Alumni Center." — continued on next page

Marty McGonigle - continued

During his schoolboy years at St. Mary's, our Inductee was a three sport athlete in football, basketball and baseball. In football Marty played four years and earned two varsity letters but had to sit out his senior year with a broken arm. In basketball, he played three years earning two varsity letters, and scored 20 or more points five times in his senior year. Baseball was Marty's strongest sport, earning him three varsity letters as the team's shortstop. After graduation from St. Mary's, Marty went on to letter in baseball at St. Peter's College.

After graduating from St. Peter's with a Marketing Degree in 1963, Marty served in the US Coast Guard Reserve from 1963-1971 and spent 40 years in the Packaging industry as Vice President of Sales & Marketing at American Can Company, Zapata Industries and Aquanautics, Inc.

Marty married Lynn Ehrle in 1964 and both are retired. They will celebrate their 50th wedding anniversary next September. They have four children and twelve grandchildren.




Bob "Bo" Santaniello – 1969

Bob "Bo" Santaniello was an indispensable mainstay of the offensive line for St. Mary's 1967 powerhouse football team. Coached by Hall of Famer, Jack Jones, the 1967 squad was an offensive juggernaut which generated nearly 2800 yards of total offense. From his right tackle position, our inductee led the charge of the running game which produced almost 2000 yards, mostly on the "33 ISO" play developed by the Gaels' coaching staff. In acknowledgment of his superlative work in the trenches, Bo was a 1st team All-Conference choice and received Honorable Mention on the Bergen Record All County Team in 1967.

In addition to his stellar gridiron work, Bo Santaniello was a powerful hitter and solid defensive performer in the outfield for the 1968 State Championship baseball team and for his senior team in 1969.

After graduation from St. Mary's, our inductee was a three-year starter at offensive tackle for Coach Jack Stephans at Jersey City State College. After completing his college degree, Bo taught school for several years and then began his long career in the gaming industry as a Floor Person at Caesar's in Atlantic City. Bo and his wife, Virginia, are the proud parents of three accomplished children, Christopher, Meghan and Stefanie.



Kevin M. Higgins – 1977


Kevin Higgins was the most versatile and prolific long distance runner in St. Mary's history. His natural speed and endurance enhanced by his dogged training and competitive spirit made him a harrier par excellence. Kevin competed at a high level in Cross-County for three years, Indoor Track for two years and Spring Track for three years, garnering a chestload of medals and commendations. In his junior year, our inductee placed first in many dual meets for Cross-Country and Spring Track, and ran to an 11th place finish in the 1976 Bergen County Cross-County Championship race, and 6th place finish in the Bergen County Track Championship in the two mile race.

In his senior year, Kevin was a top finisher in numerous prestigious cross-county races, including 5th place in the Catholic Schools Cross-Country Championship, 6th place in the

Tri-County Conference Cross-county Championship and 7th place in the Parochial C State Cross-County Championship. During that season, our inductee set new course records of 14:47 for the Wallington Cross-Country 2.8 mile course and 14:36 for St. Mary's 2.8 mile home course at North Arlington County Park. In recognition of his cross-country excellence, Kevin was voted to the 1st Team All State Parochial C, 1st Team Tri-County Conference, 1st Team Herald All Area and also gained Honorable Mention in the Bergen Record All Bergen Country Cross-Country team.

In his senior spring track season, our inductee set the school record in the two mile of 10:10, a record which stands today after 36 years. Kevin ran to 1st place finishes in most of his dual meets in 1977 and placed 4th in the Bergen County Track Championship in the two mile. During that season, Kevin teamed with Dan McNeilly, Tom Duffy and Tim Doran on one of the top four mile relay teams in Bergen County. — continued on next page



After high school, Kevin graduated from Duke University, and remains a staunch Blue Devils supporter. He is a CPA, works part-time for CIT and is the owner of Runners Haven, an all purpose running store in his hometown of Randolph, New Jersey. Kevin has continued his running ways throughout his adult life, running numerous road races and several marathons each year, training with his twins, Conor and Molly, who race for Bentley and Princeton , respectively, and his son, Seamus, a top senior runner at Randolph High School. Kevin also coaches the formidable Randolph High School girls' cross-country team, and will run his 67th marathon next month. He and his world-class bride, Maryellen, have been blissfully married for 28 years, and she is a voluble supporter of all of her family's running events.



Joe "Buzz" O'Connor - 1977

Although quarterbacks, running backs, and wide receivers usually get the most adulation on a football team, it is solid "interior linemen" like Joe O'Connor who move the offense up and down the field. An indispensable member of St. Mary's undefeated and untied 10-0-0 State Championship Team of 1976, our inductee was a three-year letter winner at the center and linebacker positions.

Joe was a hard-nosed, aggressive, consistent football player who used his speed and quickness off the ball to make and maintain his blocks. From his center position, he also made the offensive line-blocking calls and spearheaded a powerful running game which amassed over 3,000 yards rushing and 34.5 points a game for the season.

Joe earned his shot to break into the starting lineup at outside linebacker as a sophomore due primarily to his exploits as a special team player. His hustle and willingness to play

with reckless abandon earned him "Special Team Player of the Year" honors that year. He continued to start at both inside and outside linebacker over the next two years and was one of many unheralded stars in his senior season on a defense that allowed only 5.2 points per game.

In recognition of his superb performance during the 1976 campaign, Joe was rewarded with well-deserved spots on a number of post-season teams including, 1st Team All-League in the Tri-County Conference, 1st Team All-State Parochial in the Newark Star Ledger, 1st Team All-Area in the Herald News and Honorable Mention All-County in the Bergen Record for his excellence at the center position.

In addition to his gridiron heroics, Joe received three varsity letters for his sterling performance as a shot-putter on St. Mary's track team, where he made a career best throw of 45.2 feet. He was also a valued member of the Gaels' "Field Team" that won the team Silver Medal in the Bergen County Meet of Champions Javelin Relays in 1977.

After graduation Joe attended Wesley College in Delaware where he lettered on the football team. He has worked ABF Freight Systems for the last 30 years. Joe and his wife Dee reside in Rutherford. They recently completed the Philadelphia Half Marathon for "Team In Training" to raise money and awareness for the Leukemia and Lymphoma Society. They have 3 children, James, a 2003 graduate of St. Mary's, and Mike and Laura.



Nancy Sinclair-Hayes - 1999

Nancy Sinclair-Hayes performed brilliantly as a four-year varsity starter in both cross country and track for St Mary's high school during the late 1990s. During that time, Nancy's name buzzed around the hallways as her reputation in both cross country and track astonished her classmates and fellow athletes and made St. Mary high school proud. A true leader, Nancy was a star as early as her freshman year as a Gael and continued to shine throughout the remainder of her Saint Mary athletic career. In cross country Nancy excelled in the 3.1 mile event and the 800 meter 1600 meter and 3200 meter in track. Her endless dedication and remarkable work ethic led to her continually stellar performance which was reflect in the many accolades she received during her athletic tenure.

Nancy achieved all-league honors in the 800 1600 and 3200 meter events all four years at St. Mary high school. Most notably she achieved first team all-league honors in the 1600 and 3200 meter events for three consecutive years. Demonstrating her athletic prowess, Nancy also competed in the high jump and achieved first team all league in her junior year. She was recognized for multiple years on the all county teams in both the 1600 and 3200 meter events. Nancy's dominance in the 3200 meter event earned all-state honorable mention honors in her sophomore, junior and senior years.

Nancy is currently employed as a massage therapist and lives in Bergen County with her husband and two daughters.


Lyndsey Cunningham - 2001

Lyndsey Cunningham, a 4 year varsity letter winner, excelled as a softball player and was a dominant presence on the diamond during her athletic career at St. Mary. Lyndsey accepted nothing but the best from herself and played the game full-throttle, never letting up until the final out. Lyndsey's love for the game was evident every day she stepped on the field. She was a hard hitting, integral part of the softball program's success and as a freshman helped contribute to the 1998 League, County, and State Champion softball team.

Our inductee was a yearly recipient of post season honors. After a strong freshman year in which she batted .341 and was voted 1st Team All League at her 3rd base position, Lyndsey moved across the diamond to 1st base which she would call home for the next three seasons. In her sophomore year, Lyndsey batted .460 with 47 hits and 30 RBIs and

received 1st Team All League, 1st Team All County, and 2nd Team All State accolades. As a junior, our inductee had another productive season and secured spots on both the 1st Team All League and 2nd Team All County teams. During her senior campaign as a Lady Gael, Lyndsey generated a batting average of .404, amassed 38 hits, and knocked in 19 runs earning her spots on the First Team All League and All County teams.

Upon graduating from St. Mary, our inductee attended The University of North Carolina at Pembroke on a softball scholarship. Lyndsey graduated from William Patterson University with a BA in Finance. She currently works as a restaurant accountant.



1997 Sectional State Championship Softball Team

Coached by Hall of Famers, Frank Venezia and Jim MacDonald, the Lady Gaels of 1997 won the Parochial B North State Championship. This team featured an array of talented and determined athletes powered by five current Hall of Famers. These players exuded perseverance and tenacity which was evident every time they stepped onto the diamond.

During the regular season, St. Mary's went undefeated in league play, dominating the BCSL Olympic division and maintaining their winning streak in league play going back to 1994. Their regular season record earned the Gaels the #2 seed in the prestigious Bergen County Softball Tournament. In the opening round, the Lady Gaels beat a tough Indian Hills team 3-0, propelling them to the semi-finals where they lost in a close contest to River Dell.

This competitive, tenacious team earned the #1 seed in the state tournament, and advanced to the North Parochial B softball finals for the fifth year in a row with a 12-1, five inning victory over Montclair Kimberly Academy. They then defeated #2 seed Eastern Christian with strong pitching, airtight defense, and potent bats, winning the North Parochial B title 7-4.

Buoyed by their victories, the Lady Gaels headed to the Parochial B State final game for the third time since 1991. In a heartbreaking, twelve inning, 1-0 loss, the Lady Gaels fell to Red Bank Catholic, finishing their remarkable season at 28-3.

1953 Football Team – "Undefeated & Untied"

The Reunion team for the 2013 Banquet is the Hall of Fame football team of 1953, which celebrates the sixtieth anniversary of its spectacular season. In recognition of its remarkable performance, the 1953 team won the Catholic B State Championship. Coached by Hall of Famer, Leo Moran, twelve members of the 1953 squad have been inducted into the St. Mary Athletic Hall of Fame.

The 1953 team is best remembered for its iconic moments in three unforgettable games. In the first game of the season against St. Benedict of Newark, the Gaels came back to win in the final minute on a plunge into the end zone by Bob Jones followed by a nifty pass from Bob Jones to George Gaughran for the extra point.

The next memorable game was the famous "Challenge" game, in which St. Luke's of Ho-Ho-Kus challenged St. Mary's to an "in season" extra game. After the State athletic authorities sanctioned the game, the Gaels trounced St. Luke's by a score of 32-13.

In the final remarkable game of the season, St. Mary's defeated Seton Hall Prep as time was running out on a fabulous catch by Charlie Scrivanich of an aerial by Joe Dressel to tie the score. On the ensuing critical extra point play, George Gaughran faked an extra point kick and tossed a pass to quarterback, Joe Dressel, in the corner of the end zone to secure the State Championship and forge their team's place in school history.

A serious injury leads son to find family treasure in attic

s a longtime area resident and 1972 graduate of St. Mary High School in Rutherford, Rich Mariano is a tried-and-true local. His family moved to Lyndhurst in 1967 and has never truly said good-bye to the Southern Bergen County area.

And, in many ways, Mariano, one of seven children, was the all-American kid during the Vietnam War era — a teenager with a penchant for sports and a lot of close friends to have as buddies

For Mariano, one indelible memory from growing up was his track record for, well, breaking track records.

As a star athlete on St. Mary's track team, Mariano was as accomplished as they come. A local newspaper in 1968 highlighted one of his feats, writing, "Richie Mariano broke the record for the Grammar School 100-yard dash with a sparkling 10.6." At the same contest, Mariano and fellow runners, Keith Brown, Bill Weiss and Kevin Potor, broke a meet record for the half-mile relay with a "blazing" 1:46.8.

It was a time in Mariano's life that highlighted "the camaraderie and bond between cometitors," as he put it recently during an interview.

But the recollections of himself, his fellow track mates and the contests he won, were all, until recently, a fleeting memo-- a reason to be nostalgic

and teary-eyed, but that's all.

That is until Mariano fell through a roof.

Days gone by It was July 2007. In a work-related accident, Mariano took a 16-foot plunge through a sky light onto a kitchen floor, break-ing his back and leaving him on the mend for quite a while.

"I'm grateful I'm not crip-pled," said Mariano, who passed the accident off as nothing.

The injury left Mariano laid up and searching for an activity or hobby to keep him busy. Mariano's friend and former football teammate, Brian recommended he Higgins, compile his high school track statistics, as he was being considered for St. Mary's Hall of Fame.

"I started going through these boxes of things," Mariano said of his attic adventuring.

What Mariano turned up was both unexpected and ultimately life-affirming.

The discovery Mariano found film from a super-eight movie camera hundreds and hundreds of feet of film.

These weren't merely old vacations or grainy footage of past birthday parties. These were the re-creation of a period Mariano hadn't thought about in a long time: his days in high school, as a track athlete and football player.

Perhaps the payoff might seem like small beans to the average person. But for a die-hard track athlete, the films all shot by Mariano's father rekindled a spirit for an era long

gone and friendships since past. Mariano decided to place a call to Rich "Red" Kelly, a fellow track star who ran for Cresskill

High School and was prominently featured in the films. It had been years, decades in fact, since the two competitors last talked. "Of course, he remem-bered me," Mariano said of the phone call. "When he saw the films, he couldn't believe it."

Kelly said Mariano invited him to a local restaurant to meet in person and watch the films. "He pops out this DVD player and starts fast-forwarding through the films," Kelly remembered of the meet-up earlier this year. "It was really a trip down memory lane."

The reunion between the two old friends was the culmination of a wayward trip from a difficult injury to a life-changing search in the attic. Now, despite years of growing apart, Mariano and Kelly have reacquainted and joke about who was the better athlete. "I beat most of them," Mariano said with laugh. "They did beat me a ple of times.

Kelly said his races aga Mariano were more like a s decision. "That's how tr always went," Kelly said. " always see the same guys in same races, and sometimes get lucky enough to get in fr of them, and other times, see their back."

A loving tribute

The discovery was also chance for Mariano to thanks to his loving father, 184, who shot all the film clipped all the articles. father was the only guy in stands," Mariano said of his o who sold All State insurance Rutherford for years.

Without his father's tireless efforts - which may be the only efforts — which may be the only archival footage of the track meets — the younger Mariano would only have the memories in his mind. Now, he has a visu-al reminder that'll serve as a keepsake and an ever-fulfilling time capsule.

The next step in the story for

Mariano is putting together a reunion of all his sports buddies team members and competitors alike. And, of course, there's still more work to do. There are still hundreds of feet of film that haven't been seen, said Mariano, who added that it's anybody's guess how many athletes from that era he has

recorded.

In all of the talks about the films, the injury and his personal history, Mariano constantly, in an unselfish manner, points to others to shine the spotlight.
